

Scout Summer Camp General Equipment List

Each Scout stays in a canvas, two-man tent on a wooden platform and an army style cot.
Please be aware that your scout will be camping for 6 days and 5 nights. Please mark all items with the scout's last name.(Or be able to identify items later)

Class A uniform
Class B uniform
Short sleeve/tee shirts
Shorts
Swimsuit
Long pants or sweats -Mountain Men / Swimming MB will need a long sleeve shirt and pants for water survival.
Sweatshirt or light jacket
Sneakers or Hiking Boots – will do A LOT of walking! NOT NEW!
Water shoes – for river trip and showers – **No open toe shoes allowed!**
Socks (min 4 changes)
Underwear (min 4 changes)
Hat
Rain gear
Personal first aid kit
Water bottle with hanger or strap
Flashlight / headlamp with extra batteries
Sunscreen (more is better)
Insect repellent (non aerosol)
Daypack
Sleeping bag or blankets
Sleeping pad
Pillow
Drinking cup
Toiletries
Baby powder
Towels (2 min)
Watch
Notebook / pad
Pens or pencils
Scout Handbook
Merit badge books *
Money – Some MBs require kits available at the Trading Post.
Sunglasses
Footlocker or lockable Rubbermaid (suitcase works, just doesn't take rain well)
Coat Hangers (2)
Rope for clothes line
Small battery lantern – inside tent light

Notice what is not on the list? **ELECTRONICS** of any kind! So, if you wish to keep your ipod or phone, other electronic device, leave it at home.

- Some classes require you to have the book. Check our library to keep from buying it.
- It's a good idea to be familiar with your merit badge beforehand.

If you are doing the camping merit badge, you will need extra equipment. Check to see if you can buddy up with someone.
